Trophy Miniatures (NTS): Boer War Howitzer and Crew, khaki painted heavy gun, 3 RA gunners working their piece in khaki sun helmets and shirt sleeves, one of them carrying a shell, plus khaki officer with field glasses and open box of shells. Again, a very fine grouping by this maker. Original large Trophy box

81. Trophy Miniatures (NTS): Boer War Royal Field Artillery Gun Team, khaki painted gun and limber, 6 horse team with 3 riders carrying whips, 4 seated artillerymen (2 for the limber, 2 for the gun), mounted officer detachable from his horse, and a similar mounted detachable bugler. No original box for this one

82. British Bulldog (NTS): Royal Navy 12 pounder for operations on land, two ratings kneeling in Sennet hats, one holding a shell, with officer in peak cap looking through a telescope (4)

108. Asset (NTS): line infantry band marching in spiked helmets and red tunics faced green, probably the Connaught Rangers (disbanded 1922), 2 Drum-Majors this time! Grey bases (27)

## CJB MILITARY MODELS IN 1/32 (54mm) SCALE

*The following lots were produced by Colin Burkill, trading as CJB Military Models. They are impressive miniature representations of various British Army vehicles of the inter-war period. Unusual to find such a large group (12 lots) by this maker.*

***Important note:** these vehicles were displayed in the Farrell Collection without their boxes. We have tried wherever possible to reunite vehicles with what we believe to be their original box. We apologise for any misattribution or incorrect identification.*

110. CJB 1938 Morris 8 Field Wireless Car, green body, driver in peak cap plus bare headed operator with earphones and a map, radio mast (detachable), original brown cardboard box

111. CJB Light Dragon Mk II Series, tracked vehicle apparently intended for towing QF 18 pounders, peak cap driver, 5 similar soldiers (Royal Artillery?) and NCO resting his left arm on the side of the vehicle, original brown cardboard box

112. CJB Ford YMCA Mobile Canteen(1939 on) "Serving HM Forces", four-wheeled vehicle with side flap open to serve refreshments to soldiers, roof can be removed to reveal two female volunteers serving tea from an urn. A beautifully captured and evocative piece. Original brown cardboard box. Sold together with six soldiers with greatcoats. These were probably not by CJB (none are so marked) but John Farrell used them in his display to make up a queue for tea!

113. CJB Morris six-wheel Commercial CDF 30 cwt General Service Truck, with cover, peak cap driver, original brown cardboard box

114. CJB Morris ten-wheel Commercial D Type Battery Staff Car, driver in peak cap, mate, and 3 senior officers in the back, one holding an operational map, original brown cardboard box

115. CJB Morris six-wheel Staff Car, detachable cover, driver, 2 senior officers, 4 men including NCO all in peak caps

116. CJB Morris Commercial six-wheel CDF 30 cwt General Service Truck, detachable cover, driver and mate in peak caps, original brown cardboard box

117. CJB Generator Set, substantial and very technical looking piece of kit mounted on a wheeled trailer, CJB man in forage cap standing holding notebook, original brown cardboard box

118. CJB Beaverette Light Armoured Car (evidently so named in honour of Lord Beaverbrook), driver, Bren gunner and standing man in battledress and steel helmets, very minor paint loss to upper edge of one side of the vehicle, original brown cardboard box

119. CJB Morris Commercial six-wheel Covered Tractor with winch (recovery vehicle?), driver in forage cap, officer in peak cap as passenger, no box

120. CJB Morris "M" Light Utility Van, covered, spare wheel on top of cab, driver, no box

121. CJB Morris Commercial C58 15 cwt Platoon Truck, driver in battledress and steel helmet, 2 seated passengers ditto, officer in peak cap, original brown cardboard box

122. Soldiers of the Queen (NTS): British Royal Military Police 1944, 5 Redcaps, including one with tommy gun and one directing traffic, in original box. John Farrell used these figures in his display of the CJB military models

Small printed Union Jack missing from bonnet but otherwise a very nice item, complete with leaflet in distinctive original black and gold box

124. The W. Britain Premier Series, created by Charles Biggs (Britains-Petite Ltd): British 4.5 Inch Howitzer and Limber, with Service Dress Detachment 1914, gun, limber, 4 gunners in khaki and peak caps, complete with leaflet in distinctive original black and gold box
125. The W. Britain Premier Series, created by Charles Biggs (Britains-Petite Ltd): British Thorneycroft 3 Ton "J" Type Truck with Anti-Aircraft Gun (WW1), truck, gun, 4 gunners in steel helmets, complete with leaflet in distinctive original black and gold box
126. Britains vintage lead: Belgian infantry marching in service order and shrapnel-proof helmets at the slope (12), plus 6 mounted French Cuirassiers and officer (19)
